What about the scholarship?

Four \$750.00 scholarships will be awarded to four deserving students who attend a public high school in Macomb County and who enroll at a Michigan college, university or trade school in the fall and successfully complete the first semester. Upon receipt of an official transcript from the college, university or trade school, a check will be mailed to the student, payable to him or her.

Who can apply?

Any student attending a Macomb County public high school.

Selection criteria: (listed in order of priority)

- 1. Financial Need
- 2. Scholastic performance
- 3. Extracurricular activities in school and the community
- 4. Written recommendations from at least 3 persons two from teachers and one personal.
