Its biggest threats are climate change, pollution, and energy development.</p>	<p>Conservation Status: Flamingoes are not considered endangered; however, some species have had population decline. The largest threat is habitat loss due to human expansion.</p>	<p>Conservation Status: The North American river otter is not considered endangered on the federal list, but in some states the populations are decreasing due to habitat destruction and water pollution.</p>
