1. **D**ecide to ignore.
2. **E**xit, walk away.
3. **B**e calm and use friendly words (say “please stop”).
4. **U**se firm words (say “I don't like that”).
5. **G**et adult help.

All cell phones or devices should be OFF and in lockers. It is EXTREMELY important for parents to continue to monitor their child's devices! Thank you for your support.

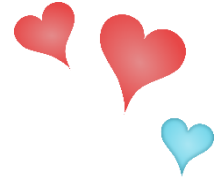
